

# Let's Play:

## An Alphabet Journey Through Space

### Learning Value:

This activity promotes development and learning by encouraging children to understand and use a growing vocabulary, as well as demonstrate use of creativity and imagination in learning and play.

### Materials Needed:

- ▶ Paper
- ▶ Writing Utensils (pen, pencil, colored pencils, markers)
- ▶ Stapler or binder clip
- ▶ Computer or tablet with internet access and/or
- ▶ Books about space



### Participants:

This activity is intended for independent play and exploration.

### Directions:

Use 26 pieces of paper and write each letter of the alphabet on a page of its own.

Using books and/or a computer as resources, find one space word or term for each letter of the alphabet. Write it on the corresponding page.

Illustrate each page with a picture of the word you have listed.

**Extensions:** Utilize the computer to complete your book; typing each of the words. Add the definition if you like. Practice changing the color of your words and the font. Use the draw function or “cut and paste” function to add pictures to illustrate your “Alphabet Journey through Space.”
