

# Math: Toy Color Sort

## Learning Value:

This activity promotes development and learning by encouraging children to compare and categorizes objects.

## Materials Needed:

- ▶ Toys that are primarily one color. Utilize 2 to 4 different colors (red truck, blue block, yellow ball, etc.)
- ▶ 3 baskets or buckets (if you don't have these you can just separate into piles)

## Participants:

This activity is intended for adult/child interaction.

## Directions:

**Step 1:** Put one toy of 2 to 4 colors in a basket, bucket, or spaced out on the floor.

**Step 2:** Challenge your child to find more toys or items that are the same colors as the toys you started with and separate or sort them into the right pile or container.

### Enrichment:

Some toys feature more than one color. For children who are ready, identify all of the color piles the toy could be separated into.
