

Reading to Infants – Parent Resource

Three reasons to read daily with your infant:

1. Create a bond and a love for this experience together before your baby is mobile and everything in the world captures their attention. Enjoy holding and cuddling your baby as you read.

2. Give your infant their first exposure to sentence structure and grammar. Changing your voice for different characters and your tone with different feelings is a first glance into the magic of literature. In no time your infant will be able to tell the difference in a sentence and a question by your voice.

3. Increase vocabulary. Infants need to hear words thousands of times before they can make all the connections with brain and muscles to make the sounds. Reading allows your baby to hear words they wouldn't typically hear in conversation and daily care routines.
