

Infant Math: See Through Shapes

Learning Value:

This activity promotes development and learning by encouraging children to compare objects.

Materials Needed:

- ▶ Cellophane squares of 4 different colors
- ▶ Paper plates (4)
- ▶ Glue stick
- ▶ Favorite toys

Participants:

This activity requires some adult preparation, but is intended for independent play.

Directions:

Step 1: Cut out shapes from the middle of paper plates. Cut out a circle, triangle, square, and rectangle.

Step 2: Cut cellophane a little bigger than the shape in the plate and use the glue stick to glue the cellophane to the plate and let it dry.

Step 3: Offer the plates to your infant with some of their favorite toys. Talk about the colors they see through the shapes.
