

Language: Story Characters



Learning Value:

This activity promotes development and learning by encouraging children to understand and interact with books and text.

Materials Needed:

- ▶ Children's books
- ▶ Paper
- ▶ Pencils or markers

Participants:

This activity is intended for adult/child interaction

Directions:

Step 1: Choose two or more beloved picture books to read together. (If children's books are not readily available, consider [Storyline Online](#), Scrib'd, or other online book platforms if necessary.)

Step 2: Choose a character from each book. Have a discussion. What are the characters like? How do they act? How do they sound? What do they look like? Do they remind you of anyone you know?

Step 3: Compare the characters. How are they similar? How are they different? Document your conversation through drawing or writing.
