Learning Value:

This activity promotes development and learning by encouraging children to understand and interact with books and text.

Materials Needed:

- ▶ Two chairs
- ▶ Blanket large enough to hide under (or fabric you can see through if your child prefers)
- ▶ Flashlight
- ▶ Books

Participants:

This activity is intended for adult/child interaction.



Directions:

Step 1 - Build a fort using two chairs and a blanket.

Step 2 - Climb under with some books and a flashlight. When your child follows you, give them a few minutes to enjoy the space and the flashlight. If your child wants to hold the flashlight, point the light down away from their eyes.

Step 3 - After you've explored your space, read the books using the flashlight.
