Let's observe Bald Eagle nests! Select a nest cam to watch for a few minutes at different times of the day today.

After observing the bird activities for a few minutes, choose one or more of these activities:

- ▶ Draw the birds in a journal.
- ▶ Write down some words about what you saw the birds doing. Ask an adult to help you write words you don't know.
- ▶ For Kindergarten Prep/ Pre-K and School Age- Research some facts about bald eagles. What is something that surprised you? What do you want to learn more about?
- ▶ Make a Bald Eagle fun fact list or book.
- ▶ Using paper and pencil, masking tape on the wall, or a measuring tape, measure your arm span against a Bald Eagle wingspan.
